15:00 BUS EXCURSION TO VOEREN

So - 31

The excursion will lead the participants to the Belgium province of Limburg, in Voeren (Moelingen), a place strongly hit by flash floods in the last years.

In recent years the village of Moelingen has been hit 3 times very hard by flash floods: in 2018, 2021 and 2024, and each flood a lot worse than the one before and worse than any known flood of the past. During the flood of 2024 the village was almost completely inundated with a peak discharge estimated to be about 150 m³/s. This has resulted in significant damage, and the inhabitants have become afraid of the river flowing through the village, the Berwijn.

But measures to drastically decrease the susceptibility to floods are not readily available. Even several large upstream flood basins would not suffice. Other measures need to be taken to mitigate the impact. In 2022 the stretch of the river through the center of the village has been widened and deepened to increase the capacity from 25 m³/s to 35 m³/s. Further widening is being planned, including the demolition of some houses nearest to the river. Other and possibly radical measures will b preceded by a comprehensive study that will probably redefine the relation between the village and its river.

In the meantime VMM and the municipality encourage inhabitants to protect themselves and their houses with flood barriers both financially and by providing support in the execution of the works.
