15:30 EXCURSION: IN THE FOOTSTEP OF ONE FOUNDING FATHER OF EUROPE

The visit of the **House of Robert Schuman** in Scy-Chazelles near Metz will give the partners a unique opportunity to explore **the origins of European cooperation**.

Preserved as it was during the 1950s, Schuman's former home provides insight into the life and legacy of one of the **principal architects of today's European Union**. Through his period furnishings, personal belongings, and carefully preserved rooms, the museum brings to life the environment in which many of Schuman's ideas for European cooperation were conceived.

The visit also presents the **key milestones of European integration** through exhibitions and multimedia displays, highlighting Schuman's vision of peace, reconciliation, and collaboration among European nations.

Combining history, heritage, and European identity, the museum offers an inspiring journey through the roots of our European cooperation project.

Transnational training on water rescue

Friday 25th September 2026

The Fire and Rescue service of the Moselle department (SDIS 57) invites water rescue organisations from North-West Europe to train among international teams in real conditions on the **Île of Saulcy, Metz, on 25th September 2026.**

This special rescue training is designed for **Aquatic rescue swimmers (SAV).**

Observers from the FlashFloodBreaker project are also welcome.

The active participants will have the possibility to take part in 4 distinct workshops:

Workshop # 1: Rescue a person who has fallen into a slow-flowing river using specific equipment, such as a boat.

Workshop # 2: Rescue a person who has fallen into a fast-flowing river

Workshop # 3: Rescue a person trapped inside a vehicle in the middle of a fast-flowing river

Workshop # 4: Rescue several persons on the roof of a vehicle in the middle of a fast-flowing river

The specific rescue materials brought by the international teams will be showcased.
